Giver Phone Script

First Time Giver Personal Email Script

Bullet Points for Phone / Email

Five hopeful outcomes from call:

- o The giver feels **acknowledged**.
- o They feel **thanked** and **appreciated**.
- o They realize **their giving makes a difference**.

- o They experience a **personal connection** with the CP.
- o They sense a **deeper connection** with the church.

General considerations

- o **Pray** before each call – make this a divine appointment.
- o Be **authentic** in your motivation – be clear around why you are calling them.
- o Remember this is **one step** in their journey. The destination is a deeper commitment to Christ, to the church, and lifetime of giving.
- o Be **yourself** – you are good at this kind of thing.
- o **Listen** well – there may be another reason for the call.

Ten talking points/questions for conversation

1. **Introduce yourself** and let them know you are calling from the church
2. Ask if this is a **good time** for them for a quick call
3. Ask them **how they found** out about “YOUR CHURCH NAME”
4. Ask them **how long** they have been attending “YOUR CHURCH NAME”
5. Acknowledge their **gift** and share with them how **grateful** the church is for their gift
6. Ask them **what made them want to invest** in the ministry of “YOUR CHURCH NAME”
7. Ask them if they know how **their gift impacts the ministries** of the church
8. Consider the “interactive dollar” explanation.
9. Let them know their giving is **making a difference** in the lives of people.
10. Close with asking them if there is **anything going on in their life** they would for you to pray about.

Possible Script

“Hi/good morning/good afternoon...! This is David from “Your Church Name”. Is this an OK time for a quick chat/do you have a few minutes?”

“I’m curious how you found out about our church. Do you mind sharing that with me?”

(Their response and your appropriate acknowledgement)

“So, how long have you/your family been attending?”

(Their response and your appropriate acknowledgement)

“There are two reasons for my call today. The first is to say thank you for your gift to “YOUR CHURCH NAME”. It’s gifts like yours and others that allow our church to make an impact for Christ. Do you mind sharing what motivated you to give to “YOUR CHURCH NAME”?”

(Their response and your appropriate acknowledgement)

“Would you like to know what happens when people give to “YOUR CHURCH NAME”?”

(Their response and your appropriate acknowledgement)
