Phone Call: Answered

THIRD-TIME GIVERS

Third-time givers typically have become dedicated supporters of your church and ministry. These givers believe in the vision, mission, and direction of your church and should be considered for volunteer ministry opportunities.

The phone call, voicemail, and texts for third-time givers are essentially the same as with second-time givers. Remember, when calling third-time givers, it is essential to check their church involvement in MortarStone or your ChMS. If they are not connected to a particular ministry or attending a church class, now is the perfect time to get them involved. During your conversation with a third-time giver remember to do the following:

- 1. Thank them for their continued financial support
- 2. Invite them to attend a church class
- 3. Connect them to online resources for small groups and volunteer opportunities
- 4. Ask them if they have a particular ministry that God's leading them towards.
- 5. End the call with information on ministry contacts.

Don't forget to take notes in MortarStone and direct their answers to the appropriate ministry leader for follow-up.
